The second 'Great Charvil Cake Off' open to all the family!

All adult category Victoria sponges should be prepared as follows:

- This should be sandwiched with raspberry jam and the top dusted with icing sugar.
- Ingredients: 150g each of fat, sugar and self raising flour, 3 eggs.
- Cook in tins that are a maximum of 20cm/8" diameter.
- Fresh cream must **not** be used to sandwich the cakes.

All child category shortbread should be prepared as follows:

- Preheat the oven to 160C/140C Fan/Gas 3 and line a baking tray with baking paper.
- Mix together 200g/7oz unsalted butter (at room temperature, cut into small cubes) and 100g/3½oz sugar, either by hand or using an electric hand whisk, until pale and smooth. Gently mix in 300g/10½oz plain flour until completely incorporated (try not to work the flour too much or the biscuits will not be so crumbly). Using your hands, squeeze the mixture together into a ball of dough.
- Gently roll the dough out to about 5mm/¼in thick (dust the work surface with a little flour if the dough sticks). Cut into shapes using a biscuit cutter . Transfer the biscuits onto the baking tray and chill in the fridge for 15 minutes to rest. (See tip for alternative method)
- Sprinkle each biscuit with a pinch of sugar. Bake for 15–20 minutes, or until pale golden-brown.
- Transfer the biscuits to a wire rack to cool and serve.

Entering the competition – IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All entries must be brought to Charvil Pavilion between 2pm and 3pm on Fete day, 7 July 2019, with a completed entry form.
- Entrants under 14 years at 1 July 2019, require a parent/guardian signature.
- All entries must be collected by 5pm on fete day, 7 July or they will be sold off with proceeds going to the fete community giving fund.
- No professional bakers please.
- Each contestant may only enter one item per category.
- Baked goods are to be prepared in a sanitary manner.
- All entries should be placed on a plate or board and covered.

Judging

- Entries will be judged from 3.30pm onwards.
- Prizes will be awarded for first prize in each category, best entry in each age group and best overall entry. These will be announced and presented once judging is complete.
